# MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

for undergraduate international students



Highly qualified international first-year students are eligible for these Wayne State merit scholarships:

- **Warrior Award** – up to \$6,500\* per year for up to four consecutive years
  - **Gold Award** – up to \$4,500 per year for up to four consecutive years
  - **Green Award** – up to \$2,500 per year for up to four consecutive years
- \*values are in U.S. dollars

Scholarships are **competitively awarded** based on a combination of grade point average and ACT/SAT scores.

**Test-optional merit awarding:** If no test score is submitted prior to admission, the university will review your eligibility for an award based on your high school GPA.

**For maximum scholarship consideration,** you must complete the undergraduate admission application (including submission of all transcripts and optional test scores) by December 1.

To retain the award, students must:

- Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Maintain full-time enrollment during fall and winter semesters
- Pass at least 30 credit hours per academic year
